Demonstrative adjectives in Spanish are used to point out specific nouns.

They must agree in gender and number with the noun they modify. Here are the common demonstrative adjectives,.

They also reflect distance from the speaker.

- -Este café está delicioso. → This coffee is delicious.
- -Esa playa es hermosa. → That beach is beautiful.
- -Aquellos monumentos son históricos. → Those monuments (over there) are historic.

Core Concepts of Demonstrative Verbs

That	ese	esa	esos	esas	Near the listener
That one (over there)	aquel	aquella	aquellos	aquellas	Far from both
